Early October I visited Kapciamiestis. I started at the old Jewish cemetery

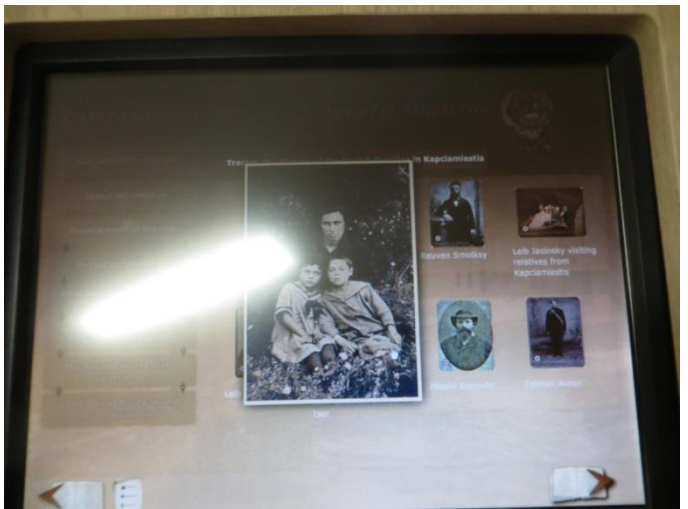


to light a Yizkor candle and pay my respects.

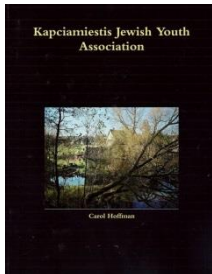
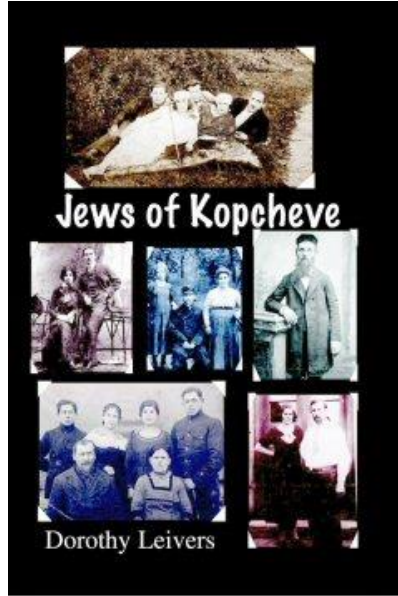
